The RCIA takes place within the context of the parish community, and after a suitable period of formation, culminates in the reception of the Sacrament of Initiation...Baptism...Eucharist and Confirmation. Formation includes several areas: Scripture, Teaching, Prayer, Liturgy and Mission. The RCIA is also suitable for adults who were baptized Catholic, but have not yet received the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.
