age groups. Follow the signs to the location behind St. Sabastian Hall. Welcome to all of our children and a special thanks to all those who are helping with this project!

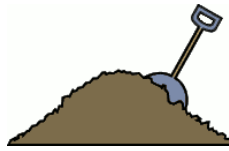
