What is RCIA? RCIA stands for Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults; a process in which individuals are received into the fullness of the Catholic Church through the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation. This is a process of faith development, focusing on prayer, sacraments, and building community through the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church. **Who should attend RCIA?** Non-baptized people with no formal religion who are now interested in the Catholic faith; People baptized in another denomination who are interested in the Catholic faith and People baptized Catholic who have never completed the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation. **When does RCIA meet?** Weekly sessions will be held on either Monday or Thursday evenings (according to the needs of the participants) beginning in mid-September and continuing through mid-May. **Please contact Sister Janet at:** janet.schneider@nativity-cincinnati.org or 531-3164.
