Leaving the house

When you are leaving the house, make sure you grab your water bottle, mask, and mask lanyard (if you have one)! Make sure your parent/guardian does a symptom check before you arrive. Your parent/guardian will send in your symptom results to the school.

Entering the building

Starting at 7:30, you may be dropped off at school. Make sure you have your mask on before leaving your car. You may not play in the courtyard with classmates before entering the building. Teachers and parent volunteers will hold signs to show the students to the correct entrance. There will be two main entrances:

- 1.) Kindergarten doors where KF, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade will enter.
- 2.) Main door where KW, 3rd, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade will enter.

Before entering the building, please use hand sanitizer from the station by the door. Keep a 3-6 foot distance between teachers and other classmates. If you are late, please go to the office.

Walking in the halls

This year while walking in the hallway, students must use the rules of the road. Stay on your right side as you are walking down the halls. Keep at least 3 feet between you and other classmates. Also, stay at least 6 feet from teachers and parent volunteers. Everyone must always be wearing their mask in the hallways and on the stairs.

Bathrooms:

Teachers will have bathroom passes in their classroom. Students should use the closest bathroom. By the bathroom door, there will be three hooks to put the pass. If all of the hooks are occupied by other passes, wait in the hall until one becomes available or go to another restroom. If there is an available hook, you may put your pass there and use the restroom. While in the bathroom, students need to keep their masks on and stay socially distant. Make sure you wash your hands and grab your pass before returning back to your room.

Water Fountains

You must bring a water bottle to school. The water fountains will not be available for you to drink from. There are three water fountains available to refill in the school, one on each floor, they are all automatic touchless refilling stations for your water bottle. You may not drink directly from the mouth spout. The water fountains are located:

1st floor: between the cafeteria and music room.

2nd floor: between the learning commons and room 206 (3rd grade 3H classroom)

3rd floor: on the right hand side of room 311 (Mrs. Semberg and Mrs. Hohl's room)

Lockers

Students in grades 6-8 are usually given lockers. This year, they will not be available to them. Students will keep all of their supplies in their backpacks for easy access and less spread of germs.

Lunchtime

Students must wash their hands before eating lunch. This will either take place in your homeroom or outside with a teacher monitor.

Recess

At recess each homeroom will be given a zone. The zones may rotate on a weekly basis. Upper school and primary (grades 1-3) will have six zones and will need six parent volunteers. Intermediate (grades 4 and 5) will have four zones and need four parent volunteers. Kindergarten will manage lunch and recess themselves. Upper school will also be given a mask and snack break at 10:30 each day. They will go in the grassy area by the old school entrance. The different zones are:

- 1.) Courtyard space near school entrance.
- 2.) Courtyard space near parish office.
- 3.) Courtyard space between school and St. Sebastian.
- 4.) Behind school/by kindergarten classrooms, but no play structure.
- 5.) Grassy area behind St. Sebastian.
- 6.) Grassy area in front of St. Sebastian (Pandora side).

Exiting the building

All students will be dismissed at 3:00 PM. Walkers and courtyard pick up will leave through the same door they entered that morning. Students in drive through will remain at their desks in their homeroom. Drive through students will be dismissed over the smart board and exit the same door they entered that morning. While leaving the building all students must keep their masks on until they are in the car.
