Who should attend RCIA: Non-baptized people with no formal religion who are now interested in the Catholic faith; people baptized in another denomination who are interested in the Catholic faith; and people baptized Catholic who have never completed the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation. **When does RCIA meet?** Weekly sessions will be held on Thursday evenings beginning September 8 and continuing through mid-May.
