**What is RCIA?** RCIA is an initiation process in which individuals are received into the fullness of the Catholic Church through the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation. This is a process of faith development, focusing on prayer,

sacraments, and building community through the teachings and traditions of the Catholic Church.

**Who should attend RCIA:** Non-baptized people with no formal religion who are now interested in the Catholic faith; people baptized in another denomination who are interested in the Catholic faith; and people baptized Catholic who have never completed the Sacraments of Eucharist or Confirmation. **When does RCIA meet?** Weekly sessions will be held on Thursday evenings beginning September 8 and continuing through mid-May.
