**International Pilgrim Virgin Statue Tour in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati:** The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima will be touring the Cincinnati area for a very limited time during the period Wednesday, July 6 through Tuesday, July 12. The world-famous International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima was sculpted in 1947 based on the description of Sr. Lucia, one of the three young seers to whom Our Lady appeared each month from May through October 1917 in Fatima, Portugal. The statue was then blessed by a bishop and designated to be a "pilgrim" or "traveler" with the mission to bring the message of Fatima to the world. The statue has already visited more than 100 countries, including Russia and China, during its multiple travels around the world, and many miracles are reported wherever the statue travels.
