VIRTUS Training for Volunteers: All new volunteers are required by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati to attend a VIRTUS Child Protection Workshop and have a background check before they may work with children. Nativity will hold another Workshop on Wednesday, October 7th at 6:30 pm in the school cafeteria. If you want to volunteer in any capacity (classroom, scouts, coaching, field trips, etc.), please register to attend the VIRTUS session by logging on to VIRTUS.org. Nativity will pay for your background check if you contact Mrs. Ciarniello (513-458-6767) in advance to get a token number to pay the \$25 fee. You must register in advance to attend this session. Because of the nature of the material being discussed, children under the age of 18 are not permitted to attend.

Liturgy Basics and the Role of the Worship Commission will be presented by Emily Besl...Adjunct Professor at Xavier University. Topics to be covered:
Session 1: Liturgy as presented in Vatican II; Session 2: The Mass; Session 3: Other Liturgical and Prayer Services. These sessions will be held on Tuesdays, October 13, 20, 27, from 7:00-8:30 pm, in the parish office basement.
