June 24, 2018 – The Nativity of Saint John the Baptist

Thank you for your continued commitment to the **One Faith, One Hope, One Love** campaign: In 2016, Nativity met it's goal of raising \$725,000 in pledges for the archdiocesan campaign. As the campaign goals stated, 20% of payments received up to goal will be returned to the parish. So far, Nativity has received five payments totaling \$79,500 which represents 20% of Nativity parishioner actual contributions made as of December 31, 2017. The next disbursement to Nativity is anticipated in July 2018 and is dependent on pledge payments made by parishioners between January 1 and June 30, 2018. Nativity's share of funds is being used for school and church renovations. Thank you for your continued commitment to the One Faith, One Hope, One Love campaign and to Nativity!
