Next Sunday's Outreach Collection will be going for the Archdiocese for Military Services, USA (AMS). The AMS is responsible for providing the full range of pastoral ministries available in all other U.S. dioceses to those serving in the United States Armed Services. The AMS receives no funding from the U.S. Government or the U.S. Military, has no parishes for a weekly in-pew collection, and must rely principally on private donations to fund an annual operating budget of over \$8.2 million.

2019 Annual Fund kicked off this past week with the goal of raising \$100,000 to improve our campus facilities. Thanks to your generosity the 2018 Annual Fund ended in September with over \$96,000 in donations, which will allow us to upgrade the restrooms in church, making them accessible to all and replace the flooring in the cafeteria.
